



Access to Ammo TDPs through FedBizOps



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- Effective 1 April 2011 ACC-RI will no longer be mailing CD-ROMs containing AMMO TDPs.
- A new process has been implemented allow access to AMMO TDPs electronically via Federal Business Opportunities (FBO).
- All contractors must obtain an FBO vendor account to access AMMO TDPs. To register for an account in FBO, please visit <http://www.fbo.gov/index> and click on “Register Now” under Vendors/Citizens. The toll free FBO helpdesk phone number is (866) 606-8220 and for international (334) 206-7828. Vendors are responsible for placing correct information in FBO.
- You may need to use special software to view the documents that are posted to the FBO. This viewing software is freeware, available for download at no cost from commercial websites like Microsoft and Adobe. Additionally, some TDPs may require ImageR and/or IndexR to view the TDP(s) and are also available as freeware at: <http://edmstag.redstone.army.mil/downloads.asp>
- A complete FBO user guide can be found on the FBO homepage under user guides “vendor” http://www.fbo.gov/downloads/FBO_Vendor_Guide.pdf

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- Once your FBO account has been activated you will be able to request/gain access to AMMO TDPs that are associated with a particular solicitation. The TDP link can be found either by:
 - Accessing the solicitation via the AAIS website:
<http://www.aschq.army.mil/ac/aaais/ioc/solinfo/index.htm> and locating the TDP link within local clause 52.211-4501 (CS6102) “Technical Data Package Information and Distribution and Destruction of Restricted Technical Data”; OR
 - By searching for the solicitation in FBO.

NOTE: This process of obtaining tech data from FBO will also be utilized to acquire updated tech data (i.e., ECPs) incorporated via solicitation amendments. Additionally, the same process may be utilized for tech data updates (i.e., ECPs) subsequent to contract award.

- Distribution “A” TDPs require only your FBO user ID and password. Once verified you will be able to access the web located TDP.
- If the distribution statement for the AMMO TDP is anything other than “A”, the TDP is considered ‘restricted’. ‘Restricted’ TDPs will require additional credentials (non-disclosures, JCP certifications, etc.) to be provided to the Contracting Officer prior to gaining access. An “explicit access request” will be required to be submitted via FBO. Please refer to aforementioned clause for instructions.
- Once the proper credentials have been provided, you will be granted access to the web located TDP. You will receive a system generated e-mail that you have been granted access from FBO. Please allow 2-3 working days after proper paper work has been provided to the contract specialist.

CLAUSE TEXT:

(a) Army Contracting Command - Rock Island (ACC-RI) will no longer make Technical Data Packages (TDPs) available for order via CD-ROMS. TDPs will be obtained electronically via the link(s) below which will direct you to the Federal Business Opportunities (FBO) website. You must have an FBO account prior to accessing any TDP(s). To register for an account in FBO, please visit <http://www.fbo.gov/index> and click on "Register Now" under Vendors/Citizens. The toll free FBO helpdesk phone number is (866) 606-8220 and for international (334) 206-7828. Vendors are responsible for placing correct information in FBO.

(b) You may need to use special software to view the documents that we post to the FBO. This viewing software is freeware, available for download at no cost from commercial websites like Microsoft and Adobe. Additionally, some TDPs may require ImageR and/or IndexR to view the TDP(s) and are also available as freeware at: <http://edmstag.redstone.army.mil/downloads.asp>

(c) FOR UNRESTRICTED TDPs:

(1) TDPs for this solicitation are unrestricted and can be accessed electronically via the FBO website. The URL will take you to that CLIN's web-located TDP. You must have an FBO account prior accessing the TDP.

(2) To access the TDP(s), click directly on the link provided below to be directed to the TDP. You may also copy and paste the link into your browser and hit the Enter key. You will be prompted for your FBO username and password prior to gaining access to the TDP.

(d) FOR RESTRICTED TDPs:

TDPs and any other related documents, if applicable, for this solicitation are restricted and can be accessed electronically via the FBO website, with valid contractor login credentials. TDPs and any other related documents are posted with various options, such as Restricted and Export Control. These additional controls are described below:

(1) Access to RESTRICTED TDPs

Technical Data Packages that have been marked as 'Restricted' can be accessed electronically via the FBO website, with valid contractor login credentials. TDPs that have been marked as 'Restricted' will require approval from the Contracting Officer prior to gaining access to the requested information. To request access click on the link(s) provided below, log in to FBO, click on the "packages" sub-tab and then click on the "request explicit access" button. Completion of a "Use and Non-Disclosure Agreement" may be required prior to gaining access to the TDP. Please allow 2-3 working days to process your request. You will receive a system generated email from FBO stating you have been granted permission for viewing or downloading the TDP items.

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Technical Data Package Information and Distribution and Destruction of Restricted Technical Data, 52.211-4501 (cont.)

(2) Access to EXPORT CONTROL TDPs

(i) TDPs that have been marked as 'Export Control' can be accessed electronically via the FBO website, with valid contractor login credentials. In addition, to obtain access to these TDPs, vendors and contractors must have a current DD 2345, Militarily Critical Technical Data Agreement on file with Defense Logistics Information Service (DLIS). If you do not have an approved DD 2345, Militarily Critical Technical Data Agreement on file with DLIS then you will not be able to access the TDP. To obtain certification, go to <http://www.dlis.dla.mil/jcp/>, click on documents and follow instructions provided. Processing time is estimated at five working days after receipt.

(ii) TDPs that have been marked as 'Export Control' will require approval from the Contracting Officer prior to gaining access to the requested information. To request access click on the link(s) provided below, log in to FBO, click on the "packages" sub-tab, enter your Marketing Partner Identification Number (MPIN) and click on the "request explicit access" button. Please allow 2-3 working days to process your request. If the company MPIN changes the user will be required to verify the MPIN again to gain access to 'Export Control' TDP(s). Completion of a "Use and Non-Disclosure Agreement" may be required prior to gaining access to the TDP. You will receive a system generated email from FBO stating you have been granted permission for viewing or downloading the TDP items.

(iii) TDPs that have an Export Control Warning Notice are subject to the Arms Export Control Act (Title 22, U.S.C., Sec 2751, et.seq.) or the Export Administration Act of 1979, as amended, Title 50, U.S.C, App. 2401 et. seq.

(3) Further dissemination of Restricted TDPs must be in accordance with provisions of DoD Directive 5230.25. This also applies to distribution of the TDP to all SUBCONTRACTORS at every level.

(4) Upon completion of the purposes for which the Restricted technical data has been provided, the Contractor is required to destroy all documents, including all reproductions, duplications, or copies thereof as may have been further distributed by the Contractor. Destruction of this technical data shall be accomplished by: shredding, pulping, burning, or melting any physical copies of the TDP and/or deletion or removal of downloaded TDP files from computer drives and electronic devices, and any copies of those files.

(5) If multiple individuals in your company need access to the Restricted TDPs for a solicitation, each individual MUST be registered in FBO and MUST submit an explicit access request and be granted approval from the contracting officer to view the TDP. If an individual with explicit access approval leaves your company, the contractor shall notify the contracting officer and the contracting officer will remove that individual's explicit access approval.
