COLONEL RONALD L. GREEN **COMMANDER, 405th AFSB**

Colonel Ronald Green assumed command of the 405th Army Field Support Brigade (AFSB) August 2010. He graduated from the University of Tampa in 1987 and was commissioned a second lieutenant in May of 1987. In 2000, he received a Master's Degree in Telecommunications Management from Webster University, St. Louis Missouri.

His first assignment was with the 9th Infantry Division, Fort Lewis, Washington serving as the Medical Platoon Leader, HHC, 1st Battalion 33d Armor; Company Executive Officer, 99th Forward Support Battalion; and as the Division Medical Logistics Officer in the 9th DISCOM. During DESERT SHEILD/STORM he was assigned as a Medical Supply Officer and S4 for the 46th Combat Support Hospital. From 1992 to 1994, he commanded Support Company, 2d Battalion, 10th Special Forces Group (A), Fort Devens, Massachusetts and Fort Carson, Colorado. From 1994 to 1998, while being assigned to Fort Bragg, he served as the S3 Operations Officer for the 528th Special Operations Support Battalion (A); SOSCOM (A) Atlantic Command Desk Officer; and as the HHC Company Commander, 1st Battalion, 1st Special Warfare Training Group (A). Colonel Green next served as a Security Assistance Officer at the US Embassy in Kuwait from 1998-1999. Upon graduation from the Command and General Staff College in 2000, Colonel Green was assigned as the G-4 for the XVIII Airborne Corps Artillery. From 2001 to 2003 he commanded Bravo Forward Support Company, 528th Special Operations Support Battalion (A) supporting Operation's Enduring and Iraqi Freedom in Jordan, Afghanistan and Iraq. From 2003-2005 he was assigned to the Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe; serving as the J-4 Log Operations officer (Asia) with duty in Baghdad Iraq. From 2005 to 2007 Colonel Green commanded the 142nd Combat Sustainment Support Battalion in Mosul Iraq and Fort Polk, LA. From 2007 to 2009 he served as the ACoS G-4 and acting Chief of Staff for the 2nd Infantry Division in Camp Red Cloud, Korea. In 2007 COL Green was selected for the Army War College but has deferred attendance in order to deploy to Korea & Afghanistan. Colonel Green served as the CJ-4 for the Combined Security Transition Command-Afghanistan in 2009-2010.



Colonel Green's awards and decorations include the Combat Action Badge, Expert Field Medical Badge, Master Parachutist Badge, Rigger Badge, and Jordanian Parachutist Wings. Decorations include the Bronze Star with two Oak leaf cluster, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters, Joint Commendation Medal, Army Commendation Medal with six Oak Leaf Clusters, Army Achievement Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters, the National Defense Service Medal, Southwest Asia Service Medal with three battle stars, Iraqi Campaign Medal with three battle stars, Afghanistan Campaign Medal with two battle stars, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary and Service Medals, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Korean Defense Service Medal, Humanitarian Service Medal, NATO Training Mission Iraq Medal, Kuwait Liberation Medal (Government of Saudi Arabia), and Kuwait Liberation Medal (Government of Kuwait).
