

SUBJECT: New Internet Based System for Export Compliance Training

Last summer I highlighted the importance on ensuring our acquisition programs comply fully with all statutes and regulations governing the export of military and dual-use technology. In an effort to help you fulfill the export compliance responsibilities for the programs you manage, my staff has created a new internet based system for use in conducting in-house training within your organization. The purpose of this new training system is to familiarize Army personnel with the processes and regulations that comprise the existing U.S. export compliance system. The new system can be accessed at the following internet address: <https://export-training.altess.army.mil>. First time users will be prompted to register as new students and provide an e-mail address that contains the .mil suffix.

The internet based training system contains seven modules on subjects relating directly and indirectly to export compliance, including separate modules on the Export Control Process, ITAR Exemptions, and Foreign Nationals at Department of Defense Facilities. The system also contains reference material, job aids, case studies, frequently asked questions, and links to official web sites for stakeholders in the export compliance community.

My intent in announcing this training system is to encourage its use as a tool to aid in the efficient management of important export compliance responsibilities.
