Brigadier General Thomas A. Harvey serves as the Deputy Commanding General, Army Sustainment Command, a position he has held since September 2011. As the DCG-Operations, he is responsible for command support to Army Forces in the United States, Europe and the Pacific.

Prior to serving as the DCG, Brigadier General Harvey served as Commanding General, 19th Sustainment Command (Expeditionary), Eighth United States Army, Korea.

Other key assignments held by Brigadier General Harvey during his career include Deputy Assistant Chief of Staff, C-4/Assistant Chief of Staff, J-4, United Nations Command/Combined Forces Command/United States Forces Korea; Assistant Chief of Staff, G-4, United States Army Pacific, Fort Shafter Hawaii; Chief of Transformation, G-7, United States Army Pacific, Fort Shafter Hawaii; Commander, 599th Transportation Group (Terminal), Military Surface Deployment and Distribution Command, Wheeler Army Airfield, Hawaii.



His military career began in May, 1980 when he was commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant and his first assignment was Platoon Leader, B Company, 4th Supply and Transportation Battalion, 4th Infantry Division (Mechanized), Fort Carson, Colorado. He holds a Bachelor of Science Degree from Santa Clara University, and a Masters Degree in Management from Webster University. Brigadier General Harvey's military education includes Transportation Officer Basic and Advanced courses at the United States Army Command and General Staff College, and courses at the United States Army War College.
