Colonel Daniel G. Mitchell Deputy Commanding Officer

Colonel Daniel G. Mitchell serves as the Deputy Commanding Officer of United States Army Sustainment Command (ASC). ASC is a global organization responsible for sustaining Army and Joint Forces in support of Combatant Commands. Colonel Mitchell leads and directs the Command's global logistics mission, encompassing a workforce of approximately 65,000 military, civilian, and contractor employees. The command is made up of a headquarters at Rock Island Arsenal, seven Army Field Support Brigades supporting Combatant Commanders, and the Army's Distribution Management Center. He provides oversight for logistics operations at CONUS and OCONUS Army installations through 73 Logistics Readiness Centers. The ASC links strategic and operational sustainment capabilities to tactical units, integrates and synchronizes materiel distribution, and enables unit readiness.



Colonel Mitchell was commissioned a Second Lieutenant at the United States Military Academy as an Ordnance officer in 1985. He has served in various Command and Staff assignments prior to assuming his current position at ASC. He came to ASC from Army Materiel Command where he performed duties as the Executive Officer to the Deputy Commanding General and the Deputy Chief of Staff. Before working at Headquarters, AMC he was the Commander of Red River Army Depot. Prior to depot command, he was the Director for Force Development at the Combined Arms Support Command in Fort Lee, VA. He commanded the 201st Forward Support Battalion (FSB), First Infantry Division in Germany, Kosovo, and Iraq; before Battalion Command, he served as the Executive officer for the Director of Force Management and as Ordnance Integrator in the Army G-3 in the Pentagon. Other previous positions include Chief, Division Material Management Center, 1st Cavalry Division; Support Operations Officer, 115th Forward Support Battalion at Fort Hood and Bosnia; Executive officer, 115th Forward Support Battalion; Maintenance Officer, XVIII Airborne Corps; Company Commander, 14th Maintenance Company, 3d COSCOM; Maintenance Officer, V Corps Artillery; and Operations Officer, Shop Officer, and Platoon Leader in the 99th Forward Support Battalion, 9th infantry Division.

Colonel Mitchell is a graduate of the Joint and Combined Warfighting School, U.S. Army War College, Army Force Management School, Command and General Staff College, CAS3, Ordnance Officer Advanced Course, and Ordnance Officer Basic Course. Colonel Mitchell holds a Master of Arts Degree in Strategic Studies from the U.S. Army War College, a Master of Science Degree in Logistics Management from the Naval Postgraduate School and a Bachelor of Science Degree in Mechanical Engineering from the United States Military Academy.

Colonel Mitchell's awards and decorations include: The Legion of Merit (w/2 OLCs), The Bronze Star Medal (w/1 OLC); The Meritorious Service Medal (w/3 OLCs); the Army Commendation Medal (w/2 OLCs); the Army Achievement Medal (w/1 OLC), the Joint, Meritorious, and Army Superior Unit Awards; the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, the Kosovo and Iraq Campaign medals; the Global War on Terror Expeditionary and Service medals; the Humanitarian Service medal, the NATO medal, the Combat Action Badge, and the Army Parachutist Badge. Colonel Mitchell also wears the Army Staff Identification Badge, the Combat Action Badge, and the Airborne Parachutist Badge.
