Colonel Peter J. Crandall Commander, 404th Army Field Support Brigade

COL Peter J. Crandall assumed the duties as commander of the 404th Army Field Support Brigade in July 2017. He is a native of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. His civilian education includes a BA in Business Administration from Concordia College, Moorhead, Minnesota, 1991; MSA in Human Resources from Central Michigan University, 2004; MMAS in Theater Operations from the Command and General Staff College, 2007. He enlisted in 1991 and served as a Finance Specialist with 1st Cavalry Division at Fort Hood, Texas. He graduated from Officer Candidate School in May 1994.

His previous assignments include: Supply Platoon Leader and Company Executive Officer, 47th Forward Support Battalion, 1st Armored Division, Baumholder, Germany (1994-1997); Support Operations Officer, 82d DISCOM; Commander Headquarters and Alpha Company, 307th Forward Support Battalion; Battalion S-3 and Commander, Echo Company (Riggers), 782d Main Support Battalion, and deployed to OIF I as the Division Parachute Officer, 82d Airborne Division, Fort Bragg, NC (1998-2003); Senior Supply Company OC (L70) followed by Senior Logistics Planner (Z04), JRTC Operations Group, Fort Polk, LA (2003-2005); G5 War Planner and deployed to Iraq as MNCI C5 Planner, XVIII ABN Corps; S4, 1st BCT, 82d Airborne Division; Executive Officer, 307th Brigade Support Battalion while deployed to Iraq, Fort Bragg, NC (2007-2010); OPS Division Chief and Detachment OIC, Special Operations Command-Joint Capabilities, Suffolk, VA (2010-2012); Battalion Commander, 725th Brigade Support Battalion (Airborne), 4/25 BCT, Joint Base Elmendorf Richardson, Alaska (2012-2014); G4 and deployed to Iraq as the CJFLCC CJ4 for Operation Inherent Resolve, 82d Airborne Division, Fort Bragg, NC (2015-2016).

Prior to assuming command of 404th AFSB, he attended Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) as an Army War College Fellow in the Center for Transportation and Logistics Supply Chain Management Program. COL Crandall's service schools include the Quartermaster Officer Basic Course, Combined Logistics Officer Advanced Course (CLOAC), Combined Arms Service Staff School (CAS3), Command and General Staff College (CGSC), School of Advanced Studies (SAMS), Army War College Fellow, Joint Forces Staff College (JMPE II), Airborne School, Aerial Delivery Material Officer Course (Rigger), Pathfinder Course, Petroleum Officer Course, and the 82d Airborne Division Jumpmaster Course.
