COL Sue Henderson **Commander, Army Sustainment Command-Army Reserve Element**

Colonel Sue Henderson assumed command of the Army Sustainment Command – Army Reserve Element on 1 March 2014. Since obtaining an ROTC Commission in 1989, COL Henderson served 11 years in the National Guard, 2 1/2 years as an IMA, and 11 years in the Army Reserve.

COL Henderson's assignments included: Platoon Leader for the 1058th Transportation Company in Hingham, MA, Battalion S-4 for the 126 Aviation Battalion in Cape Cod, Massachusetts, Commander of the 822 Movement Control Detachment in Boston, MA, Commander of the 888 Movement Control Detachment in Providence Rhode Island, Operations Officer for Military Surface Deployment and Distribution Command (MSDDC) mobilized for Operation Noble Eagle, Operations Officer for the 599th Transportation Brigade in Hawaii, Joint Mobility Officer and J3 Functional Training Officer for U.S. Transportation Command (USTRANSCOM) at Scott Air Force Base, IL., Director of Surface and Sustainment for the CENTCOM Deployment and Distribution Operations Center (CDDOC) at Camp Arifjan, Kuwait, and most recently Battalion Commander for the 2-399 REGT (TS) at Ft. Knox, KY. COL Henderson served in a mobilized or deployed status in Operation Noble Eagle, Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation Iraqi Freedom, and Operation New Dawn.



COL Henderson earned her undergraduate degree at the University of Tampa in Florida and subsequently attended the University of Massachusetts, receiving a Masters of Education (M.Ed.). Her military education includes: Transportation Officers Basic Course, Transportation Advanced Course, Combined Arms and Services Staff College. Pershing Award, and was subsequently selected to attend the Joint Forces Staff College in Norfolk, VA where she completed Advanced Joint Professional Military Education (AJPME).
