Command Sergeant Major Deborah A. Segebart CSM, LOGCAP Support Brigade

Command Sergeant Major Deborah Segebart assumed her duties with the LOGCAP Support Brigade in April 2013. CSM Segebart enlisted in the Minnesota Army National Guard in 1984 under the Civilian Acquired Skills Program and attended Basic Training as an 71L (Administrative Specialist) at Fort Dix, New Jersey.

Her initial assignment was to the HHD 47th Supply & Transport BN, Cp Ripley Minnesota., as a Administrative Specialist . She transferred to HQ STARC (Detachment 2) as a Finance Specialist in 1988 and remained until 1995 reaching the rank of Sergeant First Class and position of Quality Assurance Supervisor. Command Sergeant Major Segebart transferred to the Iowa Army National Guard in 1995 as a Procurement NCO (Purchasing and Contracting) and was assigned as the third platoon Sergeant for the HQ STARC. She was honorably discharged from the Iowa National Guard in 1998 and immediately enlisted into the United States Army Reserve as a Quartermaster NCOIC achieving the rank of Master Sergeant with the 1st Battalion, 383rd Regiment, 5th Brigade, 75th Division. In 1999 she transferred to the 19th TAACOM as a Logistics Service NCO and moved into the First Sergeant position. Command Sergeant Major Segebart was promoted to the rank of Sergeant major September 2001 and was transferred to the 561st Corp Support Group as the Support Operations Sergeant Major. She transferred to the 9th Battalion, 4th Brigade in 2004 as the School Sergeant Major and in 2005 achieved the rank of Command Sergeant Major. Command Sergeant Major Segebart has served as the Battalion Command Sergeant Major for two TASS Quartermaster Battalions and was selected to serve as the Command Sergeant Major for the LOGCAP Support Brigade April 2013.



Command Sergeant Major Segebart's military and civilian education includes the Primary Leadership Development Course, Military Pay Course, Finance Specialist Course, Battle Skills, the Basic Noncommissioned Officer's Course, Instructor Training Course, Battle Focused Instructor Training Course, the Advanced Noncommissioned Officer's Course ,Automated Logistical Specialist Course, First Sergeants Course , and the Master Fitness Course. She is a graduate of class 50 of the U.S. Army Sergeants Major Academy and the Command Sergeants Major Course. Command Sergeant Major Segebart currently holds a Bachelor of Art in Business Management from Upper Iowa University.
