Colonel Jordan Chroman Commander, 403rd Army Field Support Brigade

Colonel Jordan Chroman assumed command of the 403rd Army Field Support Brigade headquartered in Camp Henry, Daegu, Republic of Korea Jun 2013.

Col Chroman was commissioned through the Army ROTC Program at the University of California at Berkeley. His initial assignments included tours with the 12th Special Forces Group (Airborne), the 82nd Airborne Division, as the Chief of a United Nations Field Office in Bosnia, Croatia, and Serbia, and Command of the 5th QM Detachment (Airborne) in Germany.

Col Chroman later served as the Professor of Military Science at Santa Clara University, and then as a student at the Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, followed by an assignment with the 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault) during the Division's initial deployments to Afghanistan and Iraq. He then served as an Exchange Officer embedded with a Joint Unit of the British Ministry of Defence where he served as the SO1 for Operations. He then commanded the 2nd Battalion, 405th Army Field Support Brigade in Vilseck, Germany. Following command, he was assigned as a Liaison Officer in the Army's Office of the Congressional Legislative Liaison. He later served as the Deputy to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Materiel Readiness), Office of the Secretary of Defense in the Pentagon, Washington, DC.



COL Chroman has participated in numerous operations, including Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm; Operation Provide Promise; several tours in the Balkans; Operation Iraqi Freedom with both US and British Forces, and during normalization operations in Northern Ireland.

COL Chroman's military education includes the Quartermaster Officer Basic and Advanced courses, the Command and General Staff College, and the National War College. His civilian education includes a Master of Science Degree in Logistics Management from the Florida Institute of Technology and a Master of Science Degree in National Security Strategy from the National War College.

COL Chroman has numerous awards and decorations commensurate with his years of service. He is a Master Parachutist, a Pathfinder, and has earned the Combat Action Badge, Air Assault and Rigger Wings, and several other US and foreign badges.

In October 2008, COL Chroman was invested into the Order of the British Empire by Her Royal Highness, Queen Elizabeth II of Great Britain.
