Lieutenant Colonel Danny L. Robinson Commander, Army Field Support Battalion-Afghanistan

Originally from North Platte, Nebraska, Lieutenant Colonel Robinson was commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant from the University of Nebraska at Lincoln (UNL), Reserve Officer Training Corps in August 1997. Following the Transportation Officer Basic Course (TOBC), he reported to the 97th Transportation Company, 10th Transportation Battalion (Terminal), Fort Eustis, Virginia where he held positions as Heavy Boat Platoon Leader, Detachment Executive Officer, and Battalion S1. Captain Robinson completed the Combined Arms and Service Staff School (CAS3), Fort Lee, Virginia in 2001 and went on to fill the Plans and Execution Officer position for 37th Transportation Command, Kaiserslautern, Germany.



Captain Robinson took Command of the 109th Transportation Company, 28th Transportation Battalion, Mannheim, Germany in September 2003. In May 2005, he was selected to command Jupiter Recruiting Company, Miami Recruiting Battalion, Jupiter, Florida. In February 2007, as a Lieutenant Colonel he moved to Atlanta, Georgia to fill the Operations Officer, Joint Operations Plans and Executions System (JOPES), United States Army Central (ARCENT) Command G4 Transportation Branch. During his tenure with ARCENT he worked both forward and rear JOPES sections ensuring all Army personnel and equipment were moved in, around, and out of the Central Command area of responsibility.

In 2009, Major Robinson attended resident Intermediate Level Education (ILE), Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. Following completion of ILE he was assigned as the Senior Transportation Observer Controller/Trainer and as the Battalion Executive Officer for 2-383rd Training Support Battalion, Leavenworth, Kansas.

In 2013, Major Robinson was assigned as a United States Army South Logistics Planner at Fort Sam Houston, Texas. In 2014, he was promoted to Lieutenant Colonel Robinson and took over as the senior logistician on the Army South Deployable Command Post. He finished his assignment as the G4 Sustainment Division Chief sustaining all forces supporting United States Southern Command.

Lieutenant Colonel Robinson holds a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice from UNL, Lincoln, Nebraska and a Joint Planner Master of Military Art and Science degree from the United States Army Command and General Staff College, Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. His military education includes: TOBC, Combined Logistics Advance Course, CAS3, ILE, JOPES Basic Operator Course, Joint Planning Course, Joint Logistics Course, Theater Logistics Study Group, Support Operations Course, and NBC Officer Course.

His awards and decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal (4th Award), Army Commendation Medal (3rd Award), Army Achievement Medal (4th Award), Army Superior Unit Award, National Defense Service Medal (2nd Award), Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, and Humanitarian Service Medal.
