Mr. Lee Hansen Special Assistant to the Commanding General

Lee Hansen is the Special Assistant to the Commanding General, serving with the Army Sustainment Command stationed out of Rock Island Arsenal, Illinois. He is currently performing most of the duties and responsibilities normally performed by the Deputy to the Commander, a vacant position currently progressing through the hiring process.

Lee retired from the Army in 2009 with the rank of Colonel after serving 32 years of uniformed service. Lee's original enlistment in the U.S. Army was in 1977, where he began his career as a Military Policeman, stationed in Germany. Following his initial enlistment, he attended college and graduated from the University of Wisconsin at Oshkosh and was commissioned in 1982 as a Second Lieutenant in the Infantry. He branch transferred to the Quartermaster Corps in 1996. His last duty position, prior to retiring, was as the G-3 for the Army Sustainment Command. He was initially hired into Civil Service to serve as the Executive Officer (XO) to the Commanding General of the Army Sustainment Command. After serving as the XO, he served over three years as the Director of Army Prepositioned Stocks before becoming the Director of Resource Management, his position of record.



Lee holds a Bachelor of Business Degree in Finance from the University of Wisconsin – Oshkosh, and a Masters of Business Administration from Syracuse NY in Army Comptrollership as well as a Masters in Strategic Studies from the Army War College. His military education includes the Infantry Officer Basic Course, the Infantry Advanced Course, the Army Command and General Staff Officer College and the Army War College at Carlisle.

Lee's awards and decorations include the Purple Heart for combat actions in Mogadishu, Somalia, Legion of Merit (2nd Award), Meritorious Service Medal (7th Award), the Army Commendation Medal (2nd Award), the Army Achievement Medal (3rd Award), Overseas Service Ribbon (6th Award), and the Army Good Conduct Medal. His skill identifiers include the Ranger Tab, Expert Infantryman's Badge, the Parachutist Badge, and the Air Assault Badge.
