406TH ARMY FIELD SUPPORT BATTALION - CAMPBELL

History

AFSBn-Campbell executes materiel enterprise operations in direct support of the 101st Airborne Division and general support on an area bases to units within our seven state region. As a premier readiness enabler to the warfighter, AFSBn-Campbell integrates, synchronizes and delivers AMC key capabilities to increase readiness at the operational and tactical points of need supporting the Total Force to conduct a full range of Unified Land Operations anywhere at any time, dominate and win.

On 4 October 2009 Army Field Support Battalion-Campbell was activated as a permanent battalion transitioning from the 101st Logistics Support Element. From 2009-2018 the battalion had six Brigade Logistics Support Teams (BLST) deploying on a continuous basis in support of operations in the CENTCOM AOR while supporting multiple Combat Training Center rotations for Active, Reserve Component, and National Guard units. From 2016 until the summer of 2018, the battalion mission commanded four Maryland Logistics Readiness Centers (Aberdeen; Adelphi; Meade; Detrick) executing installation logistics operations in support of a number of enterprise level organizations.

On 1 May 2018, AFSBn-Campbell's mission grew as it merged with Logistics Readiness Center (LRC) Campbell, absorbing the installation logistic divisions of Transportation, Supply and Maintenance. Today, AFSBn-Campbell is a Direct Support Readiness Battalion of Army Sustainment Command, operating under the direct command of the 406th AFSB, Fort Bragg, NC.

The battalion is responsible for integrating, synchronizing, and delivering AMC's capabilities in direct support of the 101st Airborne Division (AASLT), 160th Special Operations Aviation Regiment (SOAR), 5th Special Forces Group and other Fort Campbell tenant organizations providing installation supply, maintenance, transportation and power project platform support to Fort Campbell organizations, Soldiers and family members.

As part of ASC Futures, AFSBn-Campbell, in order to improve mission command and expeditionary capabilities at the Division level, is transitioning to Division Logistics Support, Element (DLSE) operations and functions. AFSBn Campbell will be manned and equipped to deploy with and support 101st Airborne Division deployments and Combat Training Center rotations.
