Command Sergeant Major Tommy P. Fitzwater assumed responsibilities of the 406th Army Field Support Brigade June 9, 2023. He enlisted into the U.S. Army from Killeen, Texas, as a 91B Wheeled Vehicle Repairer with an Airborne Ranger contract in September 1998. He attended Basic Combat Training and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Jackson, South Carolina.



CSM Fitzwater held various positions to include shop foreman; squad leader; senior mechanic; battalion motor sergeant; ground maintenance supervisor; company first sergeant; Operations noncommissioned officer in charge; G3 (Operations) sergeant major for 13th Expeditionary Sustainment Command; battalion command sergeant major; and G4 (Logistics) sergeant major.
