Colonel Justin Todd Floyd **Commander – 279th Army Field Support Brigade**

Colonel Justin Todd Floyd assumed command of the 279th Army Field Support Brigade, Alabama Army National Guard, Huntsville, Alabama, on Sept. 6, 2025.

He previously served as the G3 (Operations) for the 167th Theater Sustainment Command, Fort McClellan, Alabama.

COL Floyd was commissioned as a second lieutenant in the Signal Corps in 2003 through the University of Alabama Reserve Officer Training Corps.

His primary assignments included platoon leader, D Company, 279th Sig Bn; platoon leader, A Company, 711th Signal Battalion; executive officer, D Co, 279th Sig Bn; company commander, B Company, 279th Sig Bn; team leader, 1960th Contingency Contracting Team; plans officer, 167th Theater Sustainment Command; commander, 1169th Contracting Battalion; and chief, Distribution Integration Branch, 167th TSC.



Deployments include serving as a Signal platoon leader with Alpha Company, 711th Sig Bn to Babylon, Iraq. He has deployed twice with the 1960th Contracting Team; once to Bagram, Afghanistan, as a contracting officer/team leader and once to Camp Bondsteel, Kosovo, as chief of Contracting for Area Support Team-Balkans.

COL Floyd's education includes a Bachelor of Science in commerce and business administration from the University of Alabama, a Master of Arts in procurement and acquisitions management from Webster University, and a Master of Arts in strategic studies from the U.S. Army War College. He is also a graduate of the Army Airborne School, Signal Officer Basic Course, Quartermaster Officer Advanced Course, Command and General Staff Officer Course, and the Functional Area 51 Intermediate Qualification Course.
