LTC Tillson's previous assignments include clothing and textiles supply chain director, Defense Logistics Agency-Troop Support, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; aide-de-camp to the commanding general, U.S. Army Materiel Command, Huntsville, Alabama; special assistant to the director of Army staff and logistics operations officer for deputy chief of staff, Army G-3 (Operations); executive officer, Washington, D.C.; support operations officer, Group S-4, 3rd Special Forces Group Support Battalion, Fort Bragg; logistics operations officer special activities and programs, U.S. Army Special Operations Command, Fort Bragg; plans officer, 3rd Infantry Division, Sustainment Brigade, Fort Stewart, Georgia.

COL Monroe has deployed twice to Afghanistan and Iraq, to Poland, and served with the NATO Rapid Deployable Corps-Turkey.

His military education includes the Quartermaster Officer Basic Course, the Combined Logistics Captains Career Course, U.S. Army Command and General Staff College, Joint and Combined Warfighting School (JPME-II), and the U.S. Army War College where he received a Master of Strategic Studies degree.

COL Monroe graduated from North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University with a Bachelor of Science in biology and was commissioned as a Quartermaster officer. He also holds a Master of Business Administration from Webster University.
