Master Sergeant Johnta Johnson assumed duties as the senior enlisted advisor of the Army Field Support Battalion-Carson, Fort Carson, Colorado, Jan. 6, 2026.

His previous assignment was battalion senior maintainer, 759th Military Police Battalion, Fort Carson.

MSG Johnson enlisted in the Army in November 2010 as a 91B wheel vehicle mechanic after graduating from college in 2008. He attended Basic Combat Training and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Jackson, South Carolina.
