Master Sergeant Antione D. Poole assumed the duties as senior enlisted advisor of the Army Field Support Battalion-Poland in December 2025.

MSG Poole previously served as first sergeant, Victor Company, 262nd Quartermaster Battalion, Fort Lee, Virginia.

MSG Poole enlisted in the U.S. Army in September 2008, where he attended Basic Training at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Lee for automated logistical specialist.



MSG Poole's first assignment was with Alpha Company, 101st Brigade Support Battalion, 1st Brigade, 1st Infantry Division at Fort Riley, Kansas, where he supported the Military Transition Team Mission for six months. He was reassigned to Golf Company, Forward Support Company, 1st Battalion, 5th Field Artillery Regiment, 1st Brigade, 1st Infantry Division. He then was assigned to Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 101st BSB, 1st Inf Div, where he deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation New Dawn from October 2010 to December 2011. Following this, he was selected for recruiting duty with Brooklyn North Recruiting Company in Brooklyn, New York. Upon completion of recruiting duty, MSG Poole was assigned to the 304th Expeditionary Signal Battalion, Camp Humphreys, South Korea from 2016-2018. From 2018-2021 he served as the first sergeant for HHC, 541st Combat Sustainment Support Battalion (Fort Riley), deploying in support of Operation Inherent Resolve. MSG Poole was then assigned to Fort Lee as an instructor for G Company, 244th Quartermaster Battalion from 2022-2023.
