## ARMY SUSTAINMENT COMMAND



The 404th Army Field Support Brigade, headquartered at Joint Base Lewis-McChord, Washington provides installation logistics, sustains Army Prepositioned Stocks (Afloat), and integrates Army enterprise capabilities to increase Warfighter and materiel readiness. On order, it deploys Logistics Support Elements in support of Army Service Component Commands.

The brigade has two subordinate Army Field Support Battalions: AFSBn-Joint Base Lewis McChord, Washington and AFSBn-Charleston, South Carolina; two Logistics Support Teams, one at Fort Irwin California and one at Fort Johnson Louisiana; and seventeen Logistics Readiness Centers located at Aberdeen Proving Ground Maryland; Adelphi Army Research Laboratory Maryland; Detroit Arsenal Michigan; Devens Reserve Forces Training Area (DRFTA); Joint Base McGuire, Dix, Lakehurst New Jersey; Fort Hunter Liggett California; Fort Irwin California; Fort Johnson Louisiana; Fort McCoy Wisconsin; Natick Soldier Systems Center Massachusetts; Parks Reserve Forces Training Area California; Picatinny Arsenal New Jersey; Presidio of Monterey California; Redstone Arsenal Alabama; Rock Island Arsenal Illinois, West Point New York and Yakima Training Center Washington.

The brigade's mission focus areas include Command and Control of Logistics Readiness Centers; the Army Materiel Command campus initiative which includes the Regional Logistics Readiness Center here on Joint Base Lewis McChord; support to I Corps and its subordinate units during operations in the Pacific; support to the National Training Center at Fort Irwin California and the Joint Readiness Training Center at Fort Johnson Louisiana; and integrating and synchronizing Army Material Command capabilities for U.S. Army Northern Command when providing Defense Support of Civil Authorities in support of disaster relief efforts.

The brigade's lines of effort include building readiness and sustaining our forces; providing depth and flexibility through mission command; and continuously taking care of Soldiers, civilians and families by creating a climate of dignity and respect. As always, the brigade stands ready to support service members wherever they are and is always prepared to "Sustain to Win."

### TIMELINE & HISTORY

Initially established in 2003 as Logistics Support Element Forward Stryker - a subordinate unit of Army Materiel Command Continental United States.

In 2004 it was reorganized as AMC Forward Stryker, subordinate to the Army Field Support Command.

In 2005, AMC Forward Stryker expanded to include command & Control of the Logistics Assistance Program.

On August 15, 2005 it was redesignated Army Field Support Brigade Pacific.

By the end of 2005, the brigade was sustaining Logistics Support Teams, post deployment reset, transformation of the 25th Infantry Division, and support to the 45th Corps Support Group.

On October 16, 2008, it was redesignated the 404th AFSB.

The brigade has continued to evolve and reorganize its force structure over the subsequent years, while always providing the warfighter with unparalleled sustainment.
