402ND ARMY FIELD SUPPORT BATTALION - ALASKA

AFSBn-Alaska (AFSBn-ALK) provides leadership to integrate and synchronize the U.S. Army Materiel Command's (AMC) materiel enterprise support to U.S. Army Alaska (USARAK) and the Alaska National Guard. AFSBn-ALK provides logistics assistance to commanders confronted with challenges beyond their resources or capabilities. The battalion performs this function through the employment of support operations sections composed of technically proficient Logistics Management Specialists (LMSs) from the Logistics Assistance Program (LAP) and Logistics Assistance Representatives (LARs) from the AMC Life Cycle Management Commands. Their primary mission is to analyze unit materiel readiness and assist in resolving equipment readiness issues.

In addition to brigade readiness support, the battalion also supports installation logistics activities at Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson, Fort Wainwright and Fort Greely. Logistics Readiness Center (LRC) Fort Greely (LRC-FGAK) provides a broad range of logistics services in a remote locale to garrison and tenant activities supporting the Missile Defense Complex, Donnelly Training Area and the Northern Warfare Training Center. Logistics Fort Wainwright and Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson provide full-spectrum logistics support to garrison and tenant activities at FWAK, JBER, Bilio Lake and Black Rapids Training Area in order to ensure warfighters are properly sustained to fight and win our nation's wars.
