Mr. James E. Allen assumed the role of Deputy to the Commander on 2 November 2015. As the senior civilian logistician to the Brigade Commander, he is responsible for full-spectrum Materiel Enterprise support throughout the Pacific Area of Responsibility. He provides subordinate unit oversight of acquisition, contract management, logistics and technology-related sustainment support to Army, joint and multinational forces, including government agencies, through a combination of direct and general support. Prior to assuming his current duties at Fort Shafter, Hawaii, Mr. Allen served as the Deputy to the Commander 404th Army Field Support Brigade; Director of Quality Assurance and Deputy Program Director-Afghanistan Logistics Civil Augmentation Program providing support to global contingencies by leveraging corporate assets to augment Army current and programmed sustainment force structure.



Mr. Allen's professional career has spanned over 47 years of service. His logistical background and assignments have included Deputy to the Commander for 3-401st Army Field Support Battalion (AFSBn) in Bagram, Afghanistan; Chief, Supply Operations for AFSBn in Afghanistan; Senior Program Analyst Joint Total Asset Visibility for PACOM, J4; Logistics Management Specialist for USARPAC, G4; Liaison Officer for AMC-Logistics Support Element-Far East; Technical Writer Force XXI and Logistics Liaison Officer to the Lebanese Armed Forces, CASCOM Training Directorate; and Logistics Management Specialist with the U.S. Army Installation Management Agency, Pacific Region. His joint experience includes assignments with PACOM, EUCOM, NATO School (SHAPE) and the Multinational Force and Observers. He is a retired Chief Warrant Officer Five, Quartermaster Corps with 30 years of active duty service, to include combat tours in Vietnam and Operation Desert Shield/Storm.

Mr. Allen holds a Master's of Science in Management with a Minor in Logistics from Colorado Technical University and a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Criminal Justice from the University of Arkansas, Pine Bluff. He received technical training in Senior Logistician Advanced Course, Sustaining Base Leadership Management Program, Force Management and Continuing Education for Senior Leaders at the Army Management Staff College. He has also completed the Executive Level Supply Chain Management training through Pennsylvania State University and holds certifications in Life Cycle Logistics (Level III) and Defense Support of Civil Authorities Phase III. As a senior Warrant Officer, he completed the U.S. Army Warrant Officer Senior Staff Course.

Mr. Allen's civilian awards include: Superior Civilian Service Award (3rd award), Commander's Award for Civilian Service (2nd award), Achievement Medal for Civilian Service, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal and NATO Medal.
