Chief Warrant Officer Five (CW5) Kevin D. Kuhn assumed the duties as the Senior Warrant Officer Advisor for the Army Sustainment Command, Rock Island Arsenal Illinois in January 2017.

CW5 Kuhn is a native of West Monroe, Louisiana where he joined the Louisiana National Guard in 1984. In 1996 he was appointed to the rank of Warrant Officer One after completing the Warrant Officer Candidate Course at Fort Rucker Alabama.

After completing the Warrant Officer Signal Basic Course at Fort Gordon Georgia, CW5 Kuhn was assigned to Bravo Company 8th Battalion 101st Aviation Regiment as the Avionics Maintenance Platoon Leader. In 2000, CW5 Kuhn was assigned to the 50<sup>th</sup> Signal Battalion (Corps Forced Entry Airborne) at Fort Bragg, North Carolina as the Battalion Signal Maintenance Warrant Officer. CW5 Kuhn then transferred to 7<sup>th</sup> Special Forces Group (Airborne), Fort Bragg, North Carolina as the Group Electronic Maintenance Warrant Officer. CW5 Kuhn was then assigned to United States Army Operational Support Element in 2004, where he served in numerous positions. CW5 Kuhn served as the Electronic Maintenance Officer, the unit G4 Maintenance Officer, and deployed several times as a part of Joint Special Operations Task Force supporting the National Mission Force.

Chief Warrant Officer Five Kuhn is a graduate of the Warrant Officer Basic Course, Advanced Course, Staff Course, Senior Staff Course, Basic Airborne School, Air Assault School, and SERE School.
